

We maintain rigorous quality control at every stage of production: a team for quality control of the wet blue, a team for quality control of the crust, and a team for all the subsequent steps until the finished product. Our dedicated teams check and monitor every phase ensuring peace of mind through our precise quality standards.



Client Access and Custom Selection

Clients are welcome to visit our facility to personally select hides, to conduct the final inspection before shipment, assisted by our specialized team. This hands-on approach underscores our commitment to quality and client satisfaction.



Leather Sourcing for the Furniture Sector

Our leather is sourced from both South America and Europe to meet high standards for the furniture industry. From South America, we procure hides from hump-free cattle, typically with only one brand mark, optimizing yield and workability. European bovine hides are chosen for premium items due to their superior grain quality.



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
