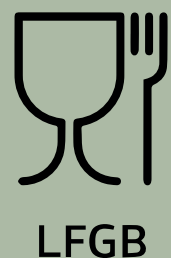

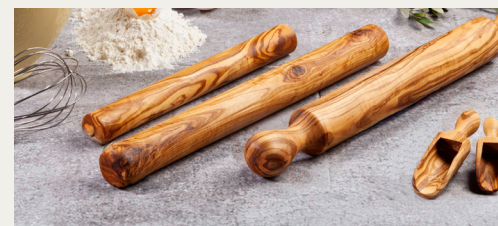


## Hygienically flawless, multi-certified

The roots of our family business go back to 1954, when my father, sculptor Curd Wilh. Jost-Pasterkamp, was the first in Germany to process olive wood into free and applied objects for the table. As early as 1954, he presented his first collection at the "intern. Frankfurter Messe", today known as 'Ambiente'. Since then, we have continued to develop our range, with a focus on unique items for the table and kitchen, as well as objects for the home. We combine classic modern design with traditional craftsmanship. Our work is appreciated worldwide. Things that evoke genuine admiration, even among spoiled tastes, for people who know how to distinguish themselves. Often copied, but never equaled.

Today we, Marcus Pasterkamp, my wife Marwa and my son Frido, carry on this tradition with passion, always focusing on impeccable craftsmanship and absolute sustainability in the use of natural resources.

## Diversity that inspires

A large selection of planks and boards are a core part of our work. Whether with or without a handle, as a "hearty" barbecue, carving or serving board. As a heart-shaped board or in a rustic, free form. These models are classics in our collection and have been very popular and tried and tested for years. The successful sales figures prove it. Each piece is cut to an individual shape according to the growth of the wood, thus avoiding waste and emphasizing the beauty of the material.
