Start

Over the years, FTA has produced hundreds of thousands of aluminum components for the coffee makers of the most prestigious Italian brands. This contribution has made possible the aesthetic and functional evolution of the moka, a timeless symbol of Italian coffee.

In May 2024, with this long legacy behind us, we decided to take on a new challenge: to design and manufacture our first coffee maker. An ambitious project that combined tradition, technical know-how and the experience of people who have dedicated their lives to this industry. Angelina's story was born in the heart of the Italian home-brewing district, an area that has given birth to and perfected the traditional moka over time. Here, where passion for design meets industrial innovation, Angelina has taken shape as a new expression of excellence.



For FTA, designing Angelina meant creating an object that serves as a daily companion, a piece of design that seamlessly integrates into any kitchen while offering coffee lovers a unique experience. Our goal was clear: to craft a product distinguished by its technical performance and timeless aesthetics, preserving Italian tradition while propelling it into new frontiers.

Design

We envisioned Angelina as a universal coffee maker, able to adapt gracefully to any kitchen, from traditional gas to modern induction stoves. This choice reflects our desire to make the coffee ritual a shared experience accessible to everyone, regardless of technology or lifestyle, while keeping the magic that accompanies each cup intact.



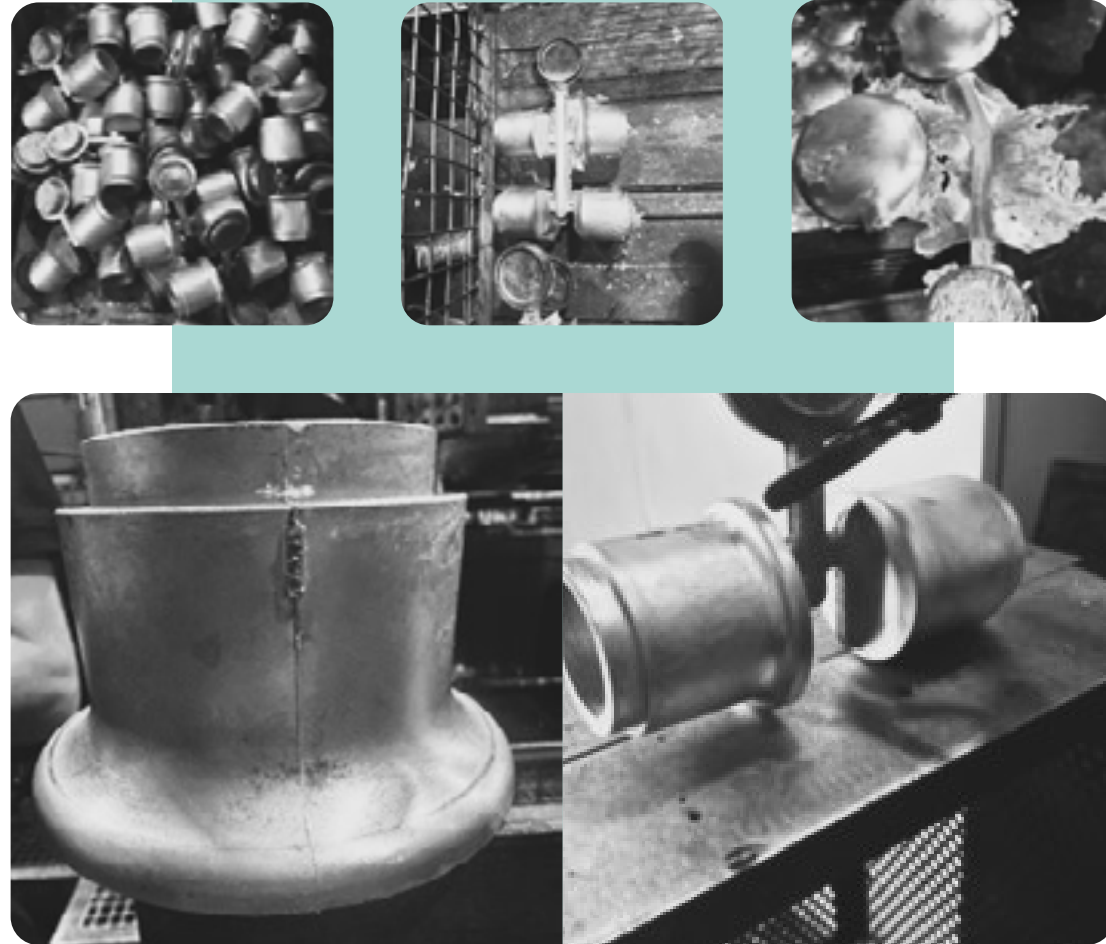
The process was an intersection of creativity and technical expertise. After sketching out the design guidelines, which had to reflect elegance and modernity, we dedicated ourselves to the creation of the first prototypes. Every detail, from the choice of materials to the definition of proportions, was taken care of with the highest attention. Angelina represents our commitment to excellence: an object that is a declaration of style, functionality and love for the Italian coffee.

Production

FTA has always made quality its hallmark. This rigorous approach has also been reflected in the development and production of Angelina, our first coffee maker.

Once the design was perfected and the technical features approved, we started production.

The choice of fine materials, such as aluminum leagues processed using advanced techniques, and rigorous control through each stage of production have ensured that the highest quality standards have been maintained.



Identity

Angelina's search for identity has resulted in a coffee maker that combines elegance and versatility. With a color palette ranging from classic to bold hues, Angelina fits every style of kitchen.

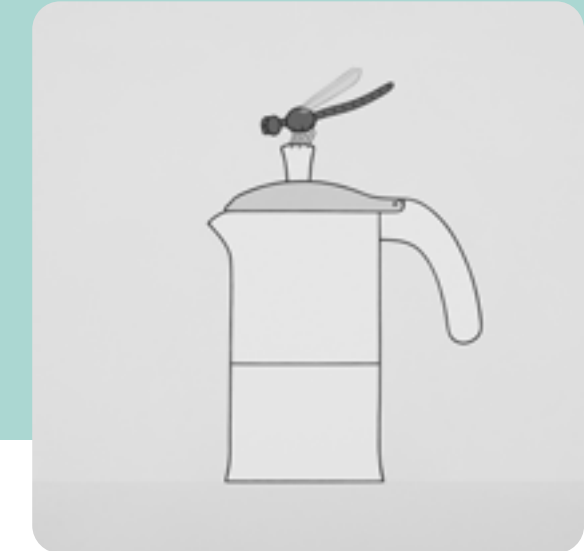
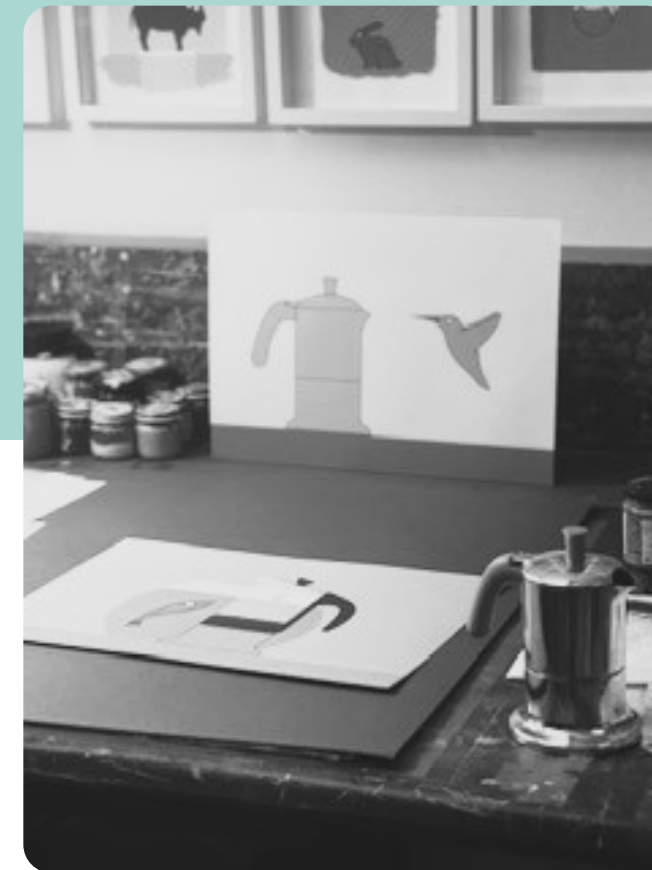

Packaging

Angelina's packaging was conceived as a central element of the project, capable of fully reflecting the identity and quality of the product. It is a container, which tells the story of Angelina, emphasizing its uniqueness. We undertook extensive research to identify the ideal packaging, exploring different options to ensure functionality, aesthetics and sustainability. From the simple white box, we moved on to something much more meaningful, because we realized that Angelina is a very special coffee maker and deserved packaging that reflected that. For this reason, we decided to collaborate with an artist who could capture and convey the unique essence of Angelina.



Massimo Caccia's work has captivated us with its disarming simplicity, capable of encapsulating a world of emotions in a few lines. His illustrations seem to give voice to Angelina, transforming her into a symbol of creativity and visual poetry. With his vision, Caccia has traced images that play with irony and delicacy, creating an immediate dialogue with the viewer. Through this collaboration, Angelina's packaging becomes a celebration of art and passion, a visual narrative that welcomes and captivates, telling a story that goes beyond the simple container to become part of the experience.
