OIL

- Professional grade artist color made with walnut oil.
- A traditional oil paint but you can be completely solvent free including cleaning your brushes with walnut oil.
- Walnut oil yellows less than other oils which is especially important in your whites, blues, and yellows.
- Walnut alkyd medium is an alcohol-based resin mixed with walnut oil. This is a drying agent, but the most important feature is increased adhesion between the paint film and the painting surface and the paint layers themselves. This makes for a more durable painting. Mix 1-3 drops per extruded inch of paint. This product is made to mix with paint and not as a varnish.

ACRYLIC

- Professional grade heavy body acrylic.
- We use a unique high solids acrylic polymer which allows us to increase pigment loads.
- It is slightly slower drying than some other acrylics which provides a longer open time.

WATERCOLOR

- Professional grade watercolor made with Northwest blackberry honey.
- Honey acts as a natural humectant so it pulls the moisture out of the air leaving our paint more moist in the palette.
- Our watercolors re-wet almost immediately even after months of disuse and resist hardening in the palette whereby providing you more time to paint and less time working in your palette.
- Your studio palette can be left in open air all year long. No need to use a sponge to get our paints moist.

GOUACHE

- Professional grade artist gouache. This is not a designers gouache.
- Designers gouache uses chalks or fillers to get the opacity. M. Graham artist gouache does not use any fillers - instead we over fill with pigment to get the matte finish and opacity.
- You can do a wash with M. Graham gouache like you can with watercolor.

All of our paints and mediums are compatible with other brands of paints and mediums.
