














YOUR MARKER, YOUR WAY



OLO DOUBLE-ENDED MARKER

Consists of two OLO half-markers, combined by the Connector Ring. A Double-ended marker has a total of 4ml of ink.



OLO BRUSH HALF-MARKER

The brush half-marker is identified by a black marker body. Holds 2ml of ink.





OLO CHISEL HALF-MARKER

The chisel half-marker is identified by a gray marker body. Holds 2ml of ink.





OLO ZERO (A.K.A. BLENDER)


The OLO ZERO is identified by a white marker body.



REPLACEMENT INK CARTRIDGE

Replacement Inks do not include a standard marker cap; reuse your empty marker's cap, reuse or replace the nib, and you are ready to color.

Once the replacement ink cap is removed, ink will not spill or drip out of the cartridge.



CONNECTOR RING

Use the Connector Ring to join any combination of half-markers and/or accessories.

Available in Black, Red, & White.



INNOVATE DESIGN

One recurring issue users faced was inadvertently removing the wrong cap from the marker end they intended to use. To address this, we made it foolproof. The black end signifies the brush nib, and the gray end signifies a chisel nib. This clear distinction ensures that users can quickly identify and select the right end without confusion. Or frustration.

Another primary concern raised was spending money for markers with dual ends or different nibs when users only utilized one end or nib. In response, we introduced customization to our markers. OLO colors connect using the innovative "Connector Ring." This feature enables users to tailor their markers to suit their preferences, whether it's brush/chisel, brush/brush, or chisel/chisel.



OLO boasts patented technology that has never been seen in an alcohol marker. Unlike other markers that utilize felt wadding, which traps and degrades ink, OLO has completely revolutionized the design with a free-flow ink system. This innovative approach addresses numerous user concerns and enhances overall performance.

OLO's tech ensures a seamless and consistent ink flow from start to finish, providing a fresh marker experience with each use.

Additionally, users reported issues with quickly depleting ink levels. This is attributed to the felt wadding acting as an ink trap, limiting ink usage to around 65%. Over time, this outdated tech not only limits the usable ink but also diminishes the overall storage capacity of the marker, forcing users to refill their marker more and more often.

OLO's innovative design and patented tech deliver consistent ink flow with over 90% usage. Smooth, consistent ink ensures superior blending.



REPLACEABLE INK

Another common user complaint centered around refilling markers. While the concept is beneficial, extensive research shows that most users do not refill their markers but instead throw their empty markers away. The challenges included an overall time-consuming and messy process, uncertainty about when the marker was full, and difficulty finding refills in-store.

OLO presents an ink cartridge system that eliminates the need for pouring, injecting, and dripping, helping avoid messy ink spills. It's simple and quick—just remove the cartridge's seal, reuse your old nib and cap, and you're ready to go in seconds.




A COLOR SYSTEM THAT WORKS



The OLO color wheel consists of three different hue saturation levels in one color wheel. It provides greater control over color selection, facilitates the creation of harmonious color schemes, aids in understanding color relationships, and is beneficial for various design and artistic applications.





Hue 0 - 1 - 2 High Saturation

Hue 3 - 4 - 5 Mid-Saturation

Hue 6 - 7 - 8 Low Saturation

Hues 0, 3, 6 are transition colors, meaning it is closer to the hue of the adjacent color family to their left. 1, 4, 7 are true colors of their color family and 2, 5, 8 are transition colors to the color family adjacent to their right.

Our markers are designed in the USA, and all materials and assembly production are located at the best factories in Japan. Our unique patented technologies in marker manufacturing are exclusive to our brand.

Are there OLO colors that can be matched to other marker brand colors?

OLO's color palette is incredibly unique. Unlike some known brands, the high-quality ink is vibrant and stays vibrant. OLO's unique color palette will complement any existing marker collection.

O S What is the recommended paper for use with OLO™ markers?

For the best results, blending capabilities, and vibrant colors, we recommend paper specifically made for use with alcohol markers. If you need help figuring out where to start, try any paper options available on olomarker.com.

Are OLO™ markers lightfast?

OLO alcohol-based ink is made with dye, so it is not lightfast. We recommend keeping your artwork out of direct sunlight and scanning your finished artwork when possible. Display artwork in a UV-blocking frame or with a protective varnish.

∩ ⊏ Are OLO™ markers refillable?

Yes. You'll love our revolutionary, easy-to-use, and mess-free Replacement Ink Cartridges. Simply replace your empty marker with a new cartridge of ink. Each cartridge costs only \$2.69 and allows you to get back to coloring in seconds, unlike the ink bottle refills used by other brands. OLO's method is faster, cost-effective, and more efficient.

 \bigcirc Is there a tool to pull out the nibs?

A specific tool is not needed to remove an OLO nib. A pair of tweezers—or your hands—should work just fine. Alcohol ink can stain your skin, so gloves are recommended. OLO nibs are durable enough to be reused, and replacement nibs are also available.

☐ ☐ The half-markers look small? Do OLO™ markers hold as much ink as other markers?

Thanks to OLO's patented technology, you can utilize over 90% of the ink volume inside the marker. In contrast, other brands that use standard technology with a felt container inside the marker deliver no more than 65% of the ink. OLO's significant efficiency boost not only maximizes the use of ink, reducing waste and the need for frequent replacements but also provides a more sustainable and cost-effective option for artists who require consistent and long-lasting performance.
