

These products are evaluated and certified to the WaterMark Certification Scheme, which is a certification scheme for plumbing and drainage products designed to ensure they are fit for purpose and appropriately authorised for use in plumbing and drainage installations.

The Australian Building Codes Board (ABCB) manages and administers WaterMark as a national scheme. The National Construction Code (NCC), Volume Three, requires certain plumbing and drainage products to be certified and authorised for use in a plumbing or drainage installation. These materials and products are certified and authorised for use through the scheme.

IAPMO has been certifying plumbing products for compliance with standards governing their use since the 1940s.





GasMark Certification

The GasMark™ gas certification scheme is JAS-ANZ accredited to ISO/IEC 17065:2012 and recognised by all Australian states' and territories' regulatory authorities. Additionally, GasMark™ labelled products may also be marketed in New Zealand, providing the New Zealand regulatory requirements have been satisfied during the assessment program.

The GasMark™ scheme is a Type Test, certification program for the certification of gas appliances and gas components covered under specific standards.

The scheme's prime attributes include:

- Certification of 'Type A' gas appliances and gas components
- Independent 'Type Test' and test report reviews
- Ongoing compliance verification via independent continuous compliance inspection regime
- The 'GasMark' provides the means to readily identify IAPMO Oceana certified gas products

Gas Tier 2 Certification

IAPMO's Tier 2 certification scheme (T2) facilitates the legal installation of "one-off" appliances, conditional on acceptance by the relevant technical regulator, as an alternative to the type-tested GasMark[™] Type A Certification Scheme.

IAPMO is the only certification body accredited by Energy Safe Victoria to administer this scheme. The scheme's prime attributes include:

- Limitation to five commercial equipment per application, of identical or like nature.
- Typically applicable to commercial catering equipment, but may include other types of appliances subject to acceptance by the relevant technical regulator.
- Dependent on the environment and complexity of an appliance, laboratory testing may be required.

The T2 Compliance Badge is exclusive to IAPMO Oceana and is used to identify products that have met specific compliance, performance and reliability requirements of selected standards.





OceanaMark Certification Scheme

IAPMO's OceanaMark™ certification scheme is JAS-ANZ accredited to AS/NZS ISO/IEC 17065 and 17067 and provides our clients with an efficient, cost effective alternative to other offerings in the market.

The OceanaMark™ scheme requires that products comply with relevant Australian and international standards and are certified under a program in accordance with the principles of ISO/IEC 17067:2013, System 5. The OceanaMarkTM Scheme covers an extensive range of products, including:

- Plumbing and water products not covered under the WaterMark Scheme: i.e. solar water heaters (performance based); valves and reticulation pipe for use in water regulators infrastructure; drainage access covers; septic tanks; etc.
- Other industry sector products where a rigorous third-party accreditation is sought.

The scheme's prime attributes include:

- Certification of products not covered under the scope of WaterMark $^{\text{TM}}$
- Independent 'Type Test' and test report reviews
- Ongoing compliance verification via independent continuous compliance inspection regime

The OceanaMark™ is an exclusive IAPMO Oceana certification mark used to identify quality products that have met specific safety, performance, reliability and efficiency requirements of selected standards.

Once earned and affixed to your certified product, the OceanaMark™ becomes an instantly recognisable symbol, providing your clients and the public with a high degree of assurance that the certified product is a quality product and fit for the purpose as outlined in the certification standard.
