Hotbath's approach to sustainability

As market leader in the Netherlands, we see it as our job to take the lead when it comes to sustainable business practices. We are constantly looking for ways to reduce our environmental impact and save water and energy: during the production and transport of our taps, at our head office and while using our products.

A true story

Hotbath deems it important to make products that are good for people *and* the environment. And truth be told, we are not there yet. Although sanitary facilities with zero ecological footprint do not exist, we deem it important to take our responsibility. For our staff and for the world we live in.

'You are never too small to make a difference.'

We are constantly looking for ways to improve and become more sustainable. Which starts as early on as the tap design process, at the drawing board, and is also an important point for attention during production, transport *and* usage. Our innovative technologies are ensuring we are making progress in the right direction. Making sustainable bathroom and kitchen taps an ever easier option, for instance.



Hotbath's approach to sustainability

Bathroom taps that save water

Hotbath is constantly looking for water-saving and energy-saving technologies. Without having to make sacrifices in terms of quality and comfort, of course! This is what makes our taps sustainable:

1. Cold Start

According to an environmental advisory service, over 25% of our gas consumption goes on heating water for the kitchen and bathroom. Which is why pretty much all of Hotbath's taps are fitted with a Cold Start, enabling you to save hot water and energy without even noticing.

How does it work? All Hotbath taps are fitted with cold start, in contrast to other single-handle taps, which commonly dispense mixed (lukewarm) water. Thereby activating the boiler or other heat source, which uses energy. Most of Hotbath's taps will only supply mixed or hot water once the handle is turned.





2. Saving water with a washbasin mixer

Whether you prefer built-in or surface-mounted, all washbasin mixer taps feature an aerator that regulates the flow of water from the tap. Thanks to this built-in limiter, Hotbath's taps dispense just 5.7 litres of water a minute. For comparison, 9-10 litres was the norm previously.



3. EcoAir System

Thanks to our EcoAir system, all our surface-mounted overhead showers will save you water. The system adds air to the flow of water. A constricted section has been introduced into the ball joint, increasing the flow rate of the water. Change Giving rise to contributing to a drop in pressure, which sucks water in and mixes it with the water. This is also called the Venturi effect. Hotbath's rain showers consume just 9 litres of water a minute.

4. Shower Power System

Our Shower Power System ensures an even distribution of water within the overhead showerhead, creating a fantastic shower experience with minimal water supply. A patented cartridge membrane system in the showerhead is used for this purpose.



5. Factories

Just as much attention is given to environmental impact during production as to during the design of the taps. Hence during production the factories' efforts are focused on:

- Separated waste collection
- At least 30% of packaging being made of recycled paper and cardboard
- Products only being supplied in 100% recyclable packaging
- Production using energy-saving machinery
- Water recovery in test labs



6. Transport

Hotbath's products are manufactured in Italy and are sold globally. It's the distributed products that are shipped via train in the Netherlands, Belgium and the United Kingdom. The taps and accessories are transported by train from the factories before being delivered to Hotbath's warehouse by lorry. Thus reducing CO_2 emissions. What's more, the lorry drivers in the Netherlands use automated route planning geared towards energy-efficient fuel consumption.



7. Head office in the Netherlands

At our head office in Alblasserdam, we do our utmost to make our processes as sustainable and efficient as possible. Properly looking after all of Hotbath's staff is part of that. Recently implemented sustainable initiatives include:

Warehouse:

- Full-colour printed boxes replaced with brown, environmentally friendly boxes
- Boxes used for shipment contain 0% plastic
- Plastic filler material in the boxes has been replaced with recycled paper
- Foam filler material has been replaced with cardboard varieties

Office:

- LED lighting has been installed in the premises
- Old paper, printer toners and batteries are being collected and recycled
- The staff are using water-saving overhead showers from Hotbath


Dream bathroom bursting with character

Carmen and Mike spent roughly a year renovating their 1930s house themselves. With its smoked glass shower wall, rectangular bath and taps made of 316 stainless steel, their bathroom is truly special. Carmen thinks it is the most beautiful room in the house. Decide for yourself and get inspired!

The taps feature beautiful details

After more than a year of renovation work, Carmen and partner Mike's detached 1930s house is nearly complete. Carmen coordinated the renovation and they did nigh on everything themselves, with a little help from family and friends. The dated 6 m² bathroom with mint-green washbasin and beige tiles was expanded to create a luxury hotel-style bathroom spanning approx. 20 m².

They sacrificed one bedroom to free up the additional space for the bigger bathroom. Carmen is not a fan of safe choices and likes doing things a little differently.



'We've got a smoked glass shower wall that runs all the way up to the ceiling and there's a bespoke, oblong bath in front of the doors leading onto the balcony. The image exuded by the taps is extremely important.

'The control knobs have the same sparkle as an LP'

I ruled out chrome or black straight away – too shiny, too faddish. In the end we went for the stainless steel Archie collection. The stainless steel is brushed, giving these taps a matt finish. I'd describe the taps' design as simple, timeless and luxurious. They feature beautiful details, like the control knobs having the same sparkle as an LP.'

Bath and bath rim combination

Carmen is up and about at six in the morning and is always on the go. 'Sometimes I've got to hit the brakes and grab some peace and quiet. How? I like having a bath and spending more time in the bathroom, particularly in the winter. There's a great view from the tub of a wooden beam of that was part of the old hearth and which we've incorporated into the ceiling. The beam separates the old bathroom from the new one. Rather than a freestanding bath mixer, which is a common sight these days, we wanted an Archie AR073 bath rim combination. It's gorgeous! We can pull out the hand shower and use it to rinse the bath clean. We largely did the renovation work ourselves, so it was really useful that Hotbath's website provides a clear technical overview of all its taps. The bath is bespoke, and I let the factory know beforehand the dimensions of the spout and shut-off valves to enable them to drill the holes into the bathtub rim.'

The Archie AR005 built-in washbasin mixers caught Carmen and Mike's eye. 'We gutted the bathroom, giving us plenty of options in terms of concealing all the pipes. It makes cleaning a smoother, more practical process', says Carmen. 'And no more limescale deposits on the washbasin!'





Repeat business for Hotbath

Lotte and Rick moved to Muiden with their daughter in 2019. Lotte designed the entire interior and chose Cobber taps for both bathrooms. Four years on and with another daughter in tow, the family has just moved to their dream house not far away. And again they have gone for Hotbath, even if they have pretty much changed everything else!

Lotte: 'Back in 2019, Hotbath was one of the few brands to be featuring coloured taps. I was keen on getting matt black built-in Cobber taps for our bathrooms and it worked out well.' Four years on and with another daughter in tow, the family has just moved to their dream house not far away. A detached, wooden house situated on the water. And again they have gone for Hotbath. 'We did consider other brands too, but Hotbath really stands out in terms of price-quality ratio, design and options. In our previous property we were delighted with our taps, so it was an no-brainer.'



New bathroom, new tap

Lotte and Rick had two bathrooms in their previous house, though in practice they only used one. This time round they went for one bathroom plus an extra washbasin unit with a Gal (GL003H) washbasin mixer in their bedroom. 'No doubt the girls will spend more time in front of the mirror once they're taller. So having an extra washbasin will come in handy.

"I'm already noticing that it's a great spot

Lotte was eager to take a slightly different approach in this house to last time. Hence they have gone for

one washbasin in the bathroom rather than two, the recess in the shower has been replaced with a plateau and they chose a different model of tap. I think Cobber is stunning, but I wanted a bit of a change. And that coincided with Hotbath launching a brand-new collection of taps. Gal has a bold appearance due to its angular lines and that really appealed to me. A welcome break from all the round shapes that are so in vogue at the moment. The brushed brass finish fits in well with the materials in our bathroom: a darkstained oak unit, ceramic tiles with a natural stone pattern and a white Solid Surface bath. The taps feature a PVD (Physical Vapour Deposition) coating to prevent the colour from fading. I love clean and new, so taps with a

vibrant patina are great but they're not my cup of tea.'

Luxury carwash

One of Lotte and Rick's wishes was a large walk-in shower. 'Rick and I pretty much never use the bathtub. My life is too hectic. But we love a shower. Our shower is 1.75 metres deep and has a shower bar (GL311) with a hand shower (Cobber M353) and a rain shower behind that (GL100). I also call it a luxury carwash', she laughs. 'It's great that we can pile into the shower with the kids and make the process of getting ready that bit quicker during the week.



Monique's job as a midwife means she sees a lot of bathrooms in other people's homes. The inspiration she has taken from these came in handy when she and her husband went looking for a new bathroom. A green herringbone tile was high on their wish list. Except she ended up coming home with something completely different...

A couple of years ago Monique and husband Hans found themselves faced with a dilemma: renovate or move house? They chose the latter and moved to a new-build property not far away, which left them looking for a new bathroom. Monique: 'My job as a midwife means I see a lot of bathrooms in other people's homes. Which is how I came up with the idea of having a wall featuring a green herringbone tile. I even made a mood board giving pride of place to the green tile. When we visited bathroom specialist Joost Post we fell in love with a green marble-look tile measuring 120x120 cm. Something completely different to what we had in mind, but we've not regretted it for an instant. We're delighted with our new bathroom.'



Perfect match: brushed copper

The marble-look tile forms the starting point and Monique and her partner are looking for bathroom furniture and taps to match. 'We discovered Hotbath's taps on our visit to the bathroom specialist. Fantastic! Our building contractor came along to the appointment and as it turned out he had plenty of experience with Hotbath. We went for the Cobber tap collection. We soon agreed that the brushed copper finish would be the best match for the green marble-look tile. Hans owns a firm that specialises in copper wire, so that's a funny coincidence.'

The brushed copper finish is one of Hotbath's Living Colours. These taps change colour naturally, and using them gives them a vibrant patina. Monique chooses to have a PVD (Physical Vapour Deposition) coating on the taps. This will keep the taps looking like new. 'I thought having a protective coating for the taps would be important to preserve their beautiful appearance. One nice touch is that the Instamat towel warmer has exactly the same brushed copper colour as the taps.'



Twice the joy with two washbasins Monique is eager to have built-in taps in the new bathroom. 'Because of the aesthetic effect. I find them better-looking and sleeker than surface-mounted taps. We chose to have two washbasins, just as we had in our previous bathroom. The washbasin mixer (CB005) buttons are both to the right. I like symmetry, you see. Hans and I aren't often in front of the mirror at the same time, but we do also share the bathroom with two of our children.'




Like being in a luxury hotel

Vincent and Janneke were on the point of selling their beautiful flat in Purmerend city centre. But now that they have turned their old-fashioned bathroom into a luxury private spa, they no longer want to leave.

Vincent and his wife Janneke generally like travelling. From the Maldives to Santorini in Greece, they have already been to a great many places across the globe. And when they are on holiday they like staying in beautifully furnished hotels. Which is where they drew inspiration for their new bathroom. Vincent: 'We wanted to create the feel of being on holiday in a luxury designer hotel in our bathroom. It needed to be a no-frills sanctuary where we can escape from day-to-day life. And we think we've done a pretty good job of it!'

Taps with a rough edge

For their new bathroom, Vincent and Janneke also drew inspiration from Pinterest and Instagram, which is how they found Hotbath. 'Plenty of taps look the same, but Hotbath's taps are anything but ordinary. We first saw the special edition Cobber X



tap in the showroom. The handle has a rough, rugged finish, which immediately won us over. The taps are real gems in our bathroom.

They're not only stunning but also very practical to use. Turning them on and off is really easy even when the handles are wet. We soon settled on matt black taps. Last year we restyled our lounge, which features plenty of black detailing too. We wanted that echoed in the bathroom.'

Turning showering into an experience Taking inspiration from the hotels they have stayed in, Vincent and Janneke chose to have an extra-large walk-in shower. The icing on the cake was an overhead shower with a diameter of at least 30 cm, which is the biggest showerhead in the Hotbath collection. 'We sometimes need a shower at the same time and it's possible to both stand under the big rain shower. We've incorporated lighting and speakers into our suspended ceiling, which we designed ourselves. We'll often put on some relaxing music in the shower, like the sounds of nature or crickets. Turning showering into a proper experience. We haven't been able to do any long-distance travel recently, but now we can go on a journey in our bathroom every day.' The couple had a water pressure booster and water softener fitted to ensure that they always have enough water pressure and to minimise cleaning. 'We use the hand


shower regularly too and wouldn't want to be without it. We were surprised by the quality of its spray. Prior to this we had a bath too, but we haven't looked back since!'

Accessories for the finishing touch

Vincent and Janneke chose to have all their taps – from their washbasin mixers to their shower taps – built in. They had the shower thermostat and the two shut-off valves fitted vertically to ensure a bold, sleek result. Grego van den Broek

WONDERFUL WELLNESS

For many years now interior architect Grego van den Broek has been using Hotbath taps in his interior designs. For this townhouse in Breda he designed a whole new interior in a warm, minimalist style. The luxury bathroom – or wellness room, you might say – is perhaps the most beautiful room in the property.



One large glass pivot door with slender wooden profiles opens from the bedroom onto the spacious bathroom in this townhouse in Breda. The bathroom is approximately six by six metres and the occupants were struggling with the layout for such an ample room. Leave it to Grego van den Broek from Grego Interior Architects. He and his team designed a warm, minimalist bathroom featuring an island comprised of dark brown oak and luxurious Taj Mahal quartzite. The floor, walls and ceiling have been finished with sand-coloured microcement. 'These materials combine beautifully with Hotbath's brushed brass taps', says Van den Broek. 'Just that little bit warmer and more stylish than black taps, for instance, which are beautiful too, as it happens.'

First the walls, then the taps

When designing a bathroom I quite often start with the wall finish, such as tiles or microcement, before moving on to woodwork and taps. The taps get chosen early on in the design process because they help set a room's image.' Van den Broek frequently works with Cobber collection taps due to the broad selection of models and colours. 'The taps in this collection are timeless, functional and clean and that ties in neatly with our style. Being able to choose from no fewer than thirteen colours is a bonus. There aren't many brands that offer such variety.'

Two washbasin mixers (CB033) have been installed in the bathroom island. 'The taps have a beautiful arch to them. The bathroom has a lot of straight, sleek lines, and the rounded shapes interrupt that.' One striking detail is that the taps have been fitted behind the washbasin, whereas the buttons are situated to the side. 'Having to reach over the washbasin to turn on the tap doesn't make sense. That's why we positioned them on the side. We like surprising people and doing things a little differently. The occupants think it's a nice touch and really practical.'







We tend to use a set template for our bathroom layout, but as Van den Broek shows, this need not be a foregone conclusion. 'The occupants wanted a calm, serene vibe for their bathroom. Which is one reason why we chose not to hang any mirrors above the washbasin. Thus preserving the room's light, open character.' They do have a mirror, of course, next to the island, dovetailing with the bathroom's style. There is even a make-up corner with an additional mirror for the lady of the house. And a floor-mounted freestanding bath and bath mixer (CB077) in front of the island.

Pure luxury

At the back of the bathroom there is a spacious walk-in shower in which two rain showers with a wall arm have been secured to the Taj Mahal quartzite rear wall. Extra-large (Ø 30 cm) overhead showers and a single shower bar with a hand shower have been chosen. 'The occupants wanted to be able to operate the rain showers simultaneously with and separately to the hand shower. Meaning we had to ensure that the buttons were logically positioned whilst being unobtrusive.' Next to the walk-in shower is an inconspicuous door leading into the toilet. Here too brushed brass accessories such as a toilet roll holder were chosen. The occupants are over the moon with the result. 'What do they think of the bathroom? They've said it's their dream bathroom. That's a tremendous compliment and we're hugely proud of this project.'

Last but not least, there is a small children's bathroom on the second floor. Here the interior architect went for a built-in shower set and separate shower bar with a hand shower. Again in brushed brass. The fact that the taps have a protective PVD coating means they will not lose their beautiful golden colour. There are built-in taps over the washbasin. 'The washbasin isn't that big, so it's more practical to have the taps coming out of the wall. And it looks great too!' •


Finishing touch to the new home spa

Kelly and Jarno's former farmhouse is over seventy years old, but their bathroom is still brand new. This was one of the first rooms in the house to be completed after extensive renovation work. Finished in chrome, the Buddy tap is the finishing touch to their new home spa.

Kelly and Jarno detached former farmhouse is nested among the cornfields in the vicinity of the town of Panningen in Limburg. They have been living there for nearly a year now and are still heavily engaged in renovating. Kelly: 'We were looking for a doer-upper that we could make our own. And that's precisely what we got, as we absolutely gutted the place. The top floor is pretty much done now. I gave birth to our daughter June three weeks after the bathroom was complete. It's fair to say we had a tight deadline!'

An extra room

The original bathroom was on the ground floor and there was just a toilet on the first floor. Kelly and Jarno decided to sacrifice one bedroom and the upstairs toilet to allow them to put in a new



bathroom. 'Now we have an extra-spacious bathroom. We chose to conceal all the taps in the wall. We didn't have any space for built-in taps in our previous property and had one surface-mounted washbasin mixer. A really lovely one: Hotbath's Buddy. It was so nice that we went for Hotbath again. The couple chose the same tap as they had in their previous house, albeit a different model: built-in washbasin mixer Buddy (BOO5J) in chrome with a curved spout. 





The PVD coating process uses a vacuum environment in a special coating chamber. In this environment, an electrical discharge or other heat source is used to vaporise metal (such as chrome, nickel, titanium, zinc or other alloys), producing a metal-containing vapour.

The atoms of metal thereby released condense and are deposited on the tap's surface, forming a thin, uniform layer. Strict temperature and pressure controls are used to manage this process, ensuring a consistent coating that will adhere nicely.


Benefits of PVD coating on taps:

Sustainability: PVD coating provides an exceedingly durable layer that is not prone to scratches, corrosion and discolouration, ensuring the tap will continue to look like new.

Aesthetic: PVD coating is available in a variety of colours and finishes, increasing the design options and lending taps a premium appearance.

Ease of maintenance: The smooth, nonporous PVD coating makes cleaning straightforward because it won't be able to attach to it inhibits dirt and limescale build-up on the surface.

Environmental friendliness: PVD coating is more environmentally friendly than some other coatings as it is a physical process that does not involve harmful solvents or emit harmful substances.

A beautiful bath tap is all part of the enjoyment of having a bath in your bathroom. Choose a tap that fits your bathroom style and wishes. You could consider a freestanding bath mixer or a bath tap with a waterfall, for example. Whatever type of bath you have, we have the perfect tap for you. Here are some of the finest bath taps!

Tap for a freestanding bath

One of the trends when it comes to baths is a freestanding bath. Beautiful in a bedroom, an en-suite bathroom or a large bathroom. A freestanding bath mixer is a great way of emphasising the freestanding nature of the bath. The bath tap is floor-mounted and can be sited anywhere around the bath. This tap is available in no fewer than thirteen colours and makes a great addition to your bathroom. It also features a hand shower, which is indispensable for rinsing the bath clean.

Corner bath? This bath tap is ideal

Installing a bath in your new bathroom is often a matter of fitting and measuring. Situating it in a corner makes the most efficient use of space. Looking for a bath tap for a corner bath? A built-in tap takes up very little space and will look sleek. You might wish to go for bath mixer (2) *Cobber CB026*, for instance. Pressing in or pulling out the middle button switches it between hand shower and bath filler mode. This bath mixer does not feature a thermostatic valve, enabling you to adjust the water temperature to your liking yourself. Just as you would with a kitchen mixer!





Bath tap for a traditional tub

What is your favourite way of taking a bath? An oval bath will have you sitting a bit more upright than traditional tubs in which you can enjoy stretching out and submerging yourself. With a traditional tub against a wall you will need a tap that comes out of the wall or is fitted on the rim of your bath. You might wish to go for a thermostatic bath mixer ④ (*Cobber B020*), for instance. It is not uncommon for people to bump into their bath tap, but that is unlikely to happen with this model. You can turn the tap to the side, you see. Or why not choose a thermostatic bath mixer with a cascade spout ③ (*Cobber B021*). Yes, that's right: a bath tap with a waterfall. What luxury!

Tap for a built-in bath

A built-in bath is usually installed against two or three walls and finished with a surround. It looks snug, is easy to clean and no water can end up behind the tub. Combine your built-in bath with a built-in bath thermostat with two shut-off valves (*Cobber CB7072*).

The shut-off valves allow you to use the hand shower and the bath spout at the same time. Which is pretty useful if you are keen to wash your hair whilst the bath is filling. This bath tap features a thermostatic valve, giving you the desired temperature immediately without any water wasted, but with a limiter to prevent the water from ever exceeding 38-40 degrees. Hence children will not be able to just turn the hot tap on. Safety first!

Tap for your hot tub


A wellness bath, spa tub or hot tub is the ultimate among baths. Magically transforming your bathroom into a home spa in which you can kick back and relax. With a spa bath you can enjoy massaging jets of water or air. There are multiple little holes in the bottom of the bath through which water, air or infrared rays pass. A bath as wonderful as that calls for a luxury tap, such as a bath rim combination (5) (Archie AR073) with a mixer, a bath filler and a hand shower. This tap also combines well with a built-in bath. Do make sure that the rim of your bath is wide enough, however.



Tapless bath? No problem!

Some people would rather keep the tap spout out of sight. One option is a bath overflow filling combination (*Pal P033*). The overflow is the button commonly found on the bath's interior. You use the overflow to control the plug, fill the bath and get rid of excess water. What's more, the bath gets filled silently without the noise of water splashing into the tub. It is not only practical but also lends your bath a sleek appearance. You might wish to have a hand shower tucked away in an alcove, which will prove useful if you want to wash your hair or rinse the bath clean.


