












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#### ABOUT US



The textile spinning unit has a machine park composed of 4 lines of opening, 15 cards, 8 rolling mills and 11 Open-Ends that make up a total of 2880 spindles. With this equipment and the full commitment of 43 employees, JFA can reach 1000 tons / month of yarn.

Production ranges from Ne 2 to Ne 60 in different mixtures.

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




Efficiency and capacity are the main goals to answer clients needs. The entire process is automated, guaranteeing delivery in less than 48 hours.

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#### YARNS

almeida

JFA has an extensive portfolio in Yarns. Raw Yarn (Fibers (100%) of Viscose, Polyester, Bamboo, Modal, Acrylic and also mixtures between them).

Dyed Yarn, resulting from different dyeing processes and apllied to different fibers.

It has also developed:

- · Papilio Yarn, a multi-colour yarn which can be produced in any type of fiber, with a combination of up to 6 different colours per reel, thereby guaranteeing the textile sector an infinite range of possibilities.
- · 360 JFA Recycled Yarn, that results from reusing textile waste from our weaving, namely, selvedges, small fabric and yarn remains. All these wastes are then cut and crushed, to which we then add a small percentage of recycled polyester. And a new yarn is born.













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# WINDING/ STITCH FINISH



In this section we are equipped with state-of-art machines, with a installed capacity of 370 spindles.

Here we transfer all the thread from our costumer to a cone, with high precision of the meters per coil. At the end of the dyeing process, there is the stich finish phase.

Besides, we perfect the threads using any Ne and fiber chosen by the costumer, to eliminate any defect in the thread.






