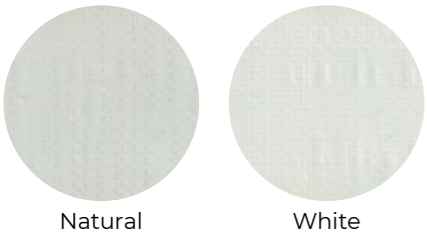

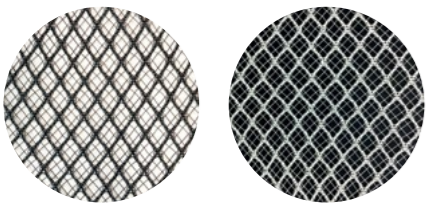

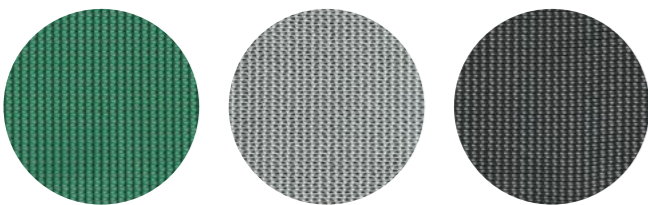

✓ **Is it phthalate-free?**

Phthalates are chemicals commonly found in PVC materials. These substances contribute to environmental pollution and can affect human health. Choose fabrics that are free of phthalates to minimise exposure.



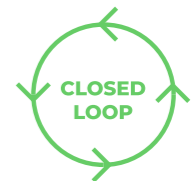
✓ **Is the fabric made by a manufacturer with GREENGUARD certification?**

GREENGUARD certification helps identify products with low chemical emissions. Choosing this certification means supporting efforts to improve indoor air quality by ensuring fewer harmful substances are released during manufacturing and fabrication.



✓ **Can the fabric be recycled after use?**

Unlike commercial textiles such as PVC, GALE Pacific polypropylene (PP) and polyethylene (PE) products are fully recyclable in Australia. Through our quest to implement a closed loop recycling program, we not only help to eliminate landfill but can ultimately convert retired product into new material.
