Colour matters.



When exposed to sunlight, the colour of the fabric is of utmost importance. The colours you choose will affect the mood of your outdoor surroundings. Contrary to popular belief, sunny beaches and gardens are a great place to use black, especially in an elegant, traditional contrast with white. Geometric patterns, stripes, chevrons or melange weaves work great if you want to create a modern, slightly exotic raw effect in your summer surroundings.



Sandy shades of beige, airy whites and stone greys resonate with reflections of sunrays to sooth your senses. A monochromatic palette of natural shades of beige and cream will help you unwind and facilitate "slow" relaxation and rest. In this context, lime yellow and green will have a fruity energetic, yet more delicate effect.
