King Leonidas and his 300 soldiers made the most notorious sacrifice of all times fighting against the Persians in the battle of Thermopylae in 480 B.C. 



Cycladic Art - solid brass ___



The History

Cycladic civilization is the most ancient in Europe and it flourished in the Aegean Sea during the 3rd millennium B.C. Their marble art was highly stylized representations of human form with minimal geometric lines which gives them a striking resemblance to today's modern art.

The King represents a strong male figure with minimal broad shoulders whereas the idol of Queen is devoted to the most significant period in a woman's life, pregnancy. The Bishop figure has indicative lines with hands under chest and legs together.

The Knight is a horse from the war of Troy, found on the bas-relief decoration of a vase in Mykonos Island. The Castle is a replica of the massive 2500-year old marble temple entrance, which is still the landmark of Naxos Island. Finally, the Pawn is the head of the most known marble idol of this period.



"It will warn you for upcoming storms. Your city will conquer the seas", he said. Athena knelt and touched the ground where an olive tree started to grow. "For food, oil, wood and light. Your city will become the symbol of civilization". Despite the rage of Poseidon, Athena's gift was preferred and ever since the city is called Athens.



Jabours of Hercules -

He helped Gods in their war with the Giants, when even his eternal enemy, Hera, Queen of Gods forgave him and offered him a place in Olympus. 

The Legend
