


Presentation of the company

In 1885 by Eugène Chabret

Founded in 1885 by Eugène Chabret in Saint-Genest-Lerpt in the Loire, the company specialises in the manufacture of cutting logs in "end-grain wood".

In 2007, attracted by this niche French production, after their respective initial experiences, Etienne Béal, sales representative, and Cyprien Meynard, production engineer, joined forces to take over Billots Chabret.

Passionate about woodworking and beautiful products, they sensed the current trend of a return to naturalness and authenticity.





100% from French forests

Chabret logs are made from "end-grain wood", hornbeam, specific species from French forests. "It all starts in the forests of the Jura where we select the finest hornbeam, known for its higher fibre density than oak. It is then a story of men and tradition. We have chosen a manufacturing method that has been mastered by our company for over a century.

We use the so-called "end grain" wood, which is sawn perpendicular to the trunk fibres (as if it were cut into slices).

The blocks obtained in this way are assembled one by one to make up the cutting board.



Wood, a living and healthy material

Wood has always been the noble material of furniture makers.

Known for its robustness, "end grain" wood is resistant to all shocks and blows from the blade. As these are applied in the direction of the wood fibre, the cutting surface can neither crumble nor break. Manufactured in accordance with the NF food hygiene standard, your Chabret block will always remain smooth and healthy.
