At the first, corn husks became waste that the local community had not maximized. Corn husks are only used for animal feed. With the existence of CV. Grandis Home, corn husks become materials that have a selling value and increase income.

CV. Grandis home **collects corn husks** from the surrounding community, the majority of whom work as farmers. Then the corn husks were purchased from farmers and then used for the manufacture of CV. Grandis Home original products. Thus, **it can indirectly have an economic impact on local farmers** that corn waste can be useful and increase people's income.







MATERIALS GRI 301

Our main raw material is natural fiber. Almost all of the materials used in the manufacture are environmentally **friendly materials products**. The materials used are sisal, corn husks, rayung, bamboo cendani, banana midrib, hemp rope, glass and plywood with glue as adhesive.

For sisal, rayung, bamboo cendani we get from suppliers. We pay great attention to the quality of the material. **Quality control is always applied in the sorting of materials**. So the best materials are used to make our products.

The waste generated from our products can still be reused, such as plywood waste, pieces of bamboo, teak wood, corn husks and sisal.

The waste of plywood, pieces of bamboo and teak is **taken by local communiy** to used as firewood. Corn husk waste is **reused for animal feed**, while the remaining pieces of sisal can be **reused as wedding dowry decorations**.

We provide waste to the surrounding community with the aim of reducing waste and the waste can be reused so its not sent to a final disposal site.
